Joseph and Natalie Connolly and Gary Patch assisted the Pathfinders and the staff with passing out bags and collecting them. God blessed us with warm, sunny weather on both days. We passed out 500 bags and received over 200 bags back. The returned bags were not just filled with one or two items but were packed. This is an excellent response to this food drive. Continue to pray for the families receiving these baskets and for all those who are struggling at this time. Our Church food pantry will be stocked for emergency requests and any leftover food will be donated to the Dracut Food Pantry.

Women volunteers over the age of 21 are needed to assist with Pathfinders for the 2009/2010 season. We have 16 Pathfinders registered and 13 of them are girls. We need COMMITTED staff. The 13 girls in the club really need adult women to guide them and share the experience of Pathfindering with them. Many have said they will help but I need more than help - it must be a commitment. This would include purchasing a uniform and being part of the Pathfinder Staff. Volunteers must be willing to attend meetings, social events, camp outs, help teach classes along with other duties. These duties can be shared if we get enough volunteers so that you don't have to be at every meeting and event. Training and assistance will be given to those willing to help. We currently have two young ladies who are attending school/college as our ONLY female staff and they cannot always be with us. PLEASE PRAY about this ministry and what you can offer to help us out.
